INTRODUCING JEN GILROY

Jen Gilroy writes romance and women's fiction – uplifting books with heart and hope – about women finding home, family and new beginnings, and finding themselves too.

What inspired the story behind *The Sweetheart Locket*?

In 2019 I visited the fantastic 1940s Home Front Museum in Llandudno, Wales. In one of the displays, I learned about the sweetheart jewellery those serving in the armed forces gave loved ones at home. From there, my story about a Royal Air Force (RAF) sweetheart locket grew. *The Sweetheart Locket* also draws on my own family history. In August 1939, one of my great-aunts, who was then working in England, returned to Canada on one of the last civilian passenger ships before war was declared. When I knew her as an elderly lady, she mused about how different her life might have been if she'd stayed in England during the war. That 'what if' question was a starting point for *The Sweetheart Locket* too.

Do you have a favourite historical period to write about?

At the moment, I'm enjoying writing about the Second World War and women's wartime roles in particular. So much of women's history has either been overlooked or hidden from the bigger historical narrative and it's exciting to learn about the often extraordinary achievements of ordinary women. I also find World War Two women's history inspiring because it's still close enough to

be within living memory for some and has helped me see members of my own family in a new light.

How did you go about researching the historical timeline in your book?

Before I started writing Second World War fiction, it was one of my favourite historical periods to read about. Several years ago, though, I read a newspaper article about women who'd worked undercover in France for Britain's Special Operations Executive (SOE). It sparked my curiosity so I began researching and reading widely about the SOE and women agents in particular. I also read published diaries of women's wartime experiences and other reference material available online and in person, including from London's Imperial War Museum. There's an author note at the end of the book with more information about my research sources, as well as suggestions for further reading.

What are you looking forward to most about hearing *The Sweetheart Locket* in audio?

I'm excited about hearing the two narrators, Polly Edsell and Regina Reagan, bring my characters and story to life. When I first heard their voices, they sounded as I imagined Maggie and Willow do so I can't wait to listen to *The Sweetheart Locket* in audio.

How important are libraries for an author?

For me, libraries are hugely important as both an author and reader. I've been an avid library user since childhood and visit my local

library every few weeks to borrow books, access online resources and request research materials. Libraries helped me learn to love books and reading and, as a child, nurture a dream of being a published author. Seeing my books in libraries is a dream come true. I also appreciate the events they host to support authors and, of course, libraries buy books in various formats which helps me reach new readers.
